Combined Rail Unions Force Rail Corp to Table

After RailCorp repeatedly refused to come to the table to negotiate the Combined Rail Unions filed with Fair Work Australia on Monday seeking an order to force them. Before Fair Work could even hold a hearing RailCorp has folded and agreed to bargain.

The first negotiation meeting between RailCorp and the Combined Rail Unions will be held next Tuesday 16 February, a mere 44 days before the agreement expires.

We are ready to get down to the business of securing a new improved agreement for our members.

Union members do not have to do anything to have a voice at the bargaining table.
