RAILCORP DELAYS START OF NEGOTIATIONS DAYS UNTIL AGREEMENT HAS TO BE REACHED: 80

The Combined Rail Unions are ready to negotiate now

The Combined Rail Unions wrote to RailCorp late last year seeking to commence negotiations for our new Agreement. Our members know from experience that negotiating the Agreement can be a long and frustrating process. **We want to start negotiating immediately to make sure our members have a new Agreement with fair pay and conditions in place before the current one expires.**

But RailCorp and the Government want to wait...

RailCorp responded to the unions saying that they need to carry out "a number of steps" set out by the NSW Government Wages Policy before they will even start bargaining.

The Unions are concerned that delays such as these will mean our members have to wait longer for a fair outcome from the negotiations.

Members want action now

RailCorp and the Government need to know that our members are serious: **We will not sit back and wait for RailCorp; we want them at the table now.**

RailCorp and the Government need to know how many RailCorp workers are serious about getting on with the negotiations.
